The People of the State of Nevada do Enact As Follows:

Amendment II of the Constitution of the United States:

A well-regulated Militia, being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep and bear Arms, shall not be infrinced. keep and bear Arms, shall not be infringed.

Amendment X of the Constitution of the United States

The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the States, are reserved to the States respectively, or to the people.

Description of Effect

The Constitution of the United States has granted the American people the right to bear arms, with a guarantee that it will not be infringed. The Heller decision stated that while the Second Amendment is a right, it is not an unalienable right, and to that effect there are reasonable limits.
