

**FINANCIAL IMPACT OF THE INITIATIVE PETITION TO AMEND THE
NEVADA CONSTITUTION – IDENTIFIER: C-01-2019 (AMENDED)**

The Initiative Petition to Amend the *Nevada Constitution* – Identifier: C-01-2019 (Amended) proposes to amend Article 4, Section 4 of the *Nevada Constitution* by making the following changes to the membership and composition of the Nevada State Senate:

- The term of a State Senator is reduced from four years to two years;
- The number of Senators is fixed at a total of five for each district;
- A minimum of four Senate districts must be established in Nevada; and
- The balloting for State Senator at each election shall be conducted using a single transferable vote.

The Fiscal Analysis Division is unable to provide a completed financial impact statement to be posted by the Secretary of State's Office within the ten business days prescribed pursuant to NRS 295.015. A fiscal note that includes an explanation of any financial impact will be provided to the Secretary of State when completed for posting on their Internet website, pursuant to NRS 295.015.
