### Nevada Reapportionment and Electoral College Information

#### Nevada Congressional Districts (Reapportioned in 2012)

In 2010 the United States conducted its Census (constitutionally done every ten years). The results of this census revealed that Nevada had once again gained a large number of residents which resulted in Nevada receiving one additional representative in the US House of Representatives, which in turn gives Nevada one additional electoral vote in the presidential election for a grand total of 6. Since the 1980 Census (Congressional District 3 was from the 2000 census) Nevada has gained 3 congressional districts.

The Census has not only changed our US House and Electoral College representation, but it also changes our State Senate and Assembly Districts.
