

Step-by-Step Instructions for Voting and Viewing Results

Voting in the Student Mock Election is easy. There are two ways to vote: Online or by Paper Ballot.

Online Ballot

1. After registering, your Administrator/Coordinator Login and Password will be emailed to you by the State program. Use this Login and Password to access your School Administrator/Coordinator page at: <https://youthvote.nv.gov/Pages/Login?ReturnUrl=%2fSecure%2fSchoolAdmin.aspx>
2. After logging in, enter the number of student logins requested and click “add.”
3. Select either “View on Page” or “Save as Excel” to view the number of logins requested.
4. . Administrator/Coordinator will issue student logins (Voter ID and Passwords) to participating teachers. The Voter ID and Passwords can now be used to access, mark, and vote a ballot once voting begins.
5. To request more student logins, repeat steps 2 and 3.

Paper Ballot

1. Paper ballots can be downloaded from: <https://youthvote.nv.gov/Default?target=ballots>
2. Once printed, the ballots can be voted by hand (like an absentee ballot).
3. Tabulate paper ballots by hand. (i.e. educator, Student Council, Government class, etc.)
4. Add the results from the paper ballots to YouthVote.NV.gov:
 - i) Log in to your School Administrator/Coordinator page at: <https://youthvote.nv.gov/Pages/Login?ReturnUrl=%2fSecure%2fSchoolAdmin.aspx>
 - ii) Under the section of the page labeled *Enter and display your school's vote*, select “Enter batch vote from paper ballots for _ School”

View Results

1. Go to YouthVote.NV.gov and log in.
2. On the top horizontal menu, select “Results.”
3. You may use the drop-down menus at the top of the page to filter results by School, Statewide and Congressional districts.

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
